CAMP PROJECT GRADE 8, 2018

The Kenyan coast has a combination of historical sites, the Port of Mombasa, super beaches and a rich cultural heritage. The town of Mombasa has a history going as far back as the 12th century. The coast shows heavy Portuguese, Arabic and Indian influence. North and south of Mombasa have some of the finest beaches in Africa.

Unfortunately; most Kenyans have had no opportunity to explore and learn from this rich region. The economic status of most of the parents has made most of the children disadvantaged from visiting the Kenyan coast.

In this year, Rudolf Steiner School Mbagathi is planning to take grade eight students to the coast. The camp is expected to take five days. During the camp: our children will have an opportunity to visit Vasco Da Gama Pillar in Malindi, Marine Park, Gede Ruins, the famous Fort Jesus, Haller Park, old town, the port of Mombasa and Utamaduni and the Cultural Centre.

They will also have recreational activities in the Indian Ocean through boat racing and swimming activities in both Kenyatta beach and Ndiani beaches. The students will be hosted at the famous Mombasa Island; one of the oldest towns in Kenya.
